

# ***DID YOU KNOW?***

- Floridians have NO constitutional rights or protections in Florida family courts when seeking a divorce.
- Florida Courts have ruled that the State of Florida is a 3rd party in your marriage and that the state's interests are paramount to yours even though those interests are not clearly defined.
- Florida family court judges do not have to follow divorce laws if they don't want to.
- The state can take any of your assets and give them to your ex-spouse as alimony; including your Social Security, 401K, military retirement, your house, your car, your future income, and even money paid to you because you are disabled regardless of other income or assets your ex-spouse may already possess or their health condition and there is nothing you can do about it.
- If you are a 2nd wife or husband, a family court judge is free to go after your assets and income to pay alimony to an ex-spouse even to the detriment of your children.
- Florida's judges have thumbed their noses at SB152 that allows alimony payers to downward modify their alimony payments if their ex-spouse cohabits with another. To date nobody has been granted relief; not even the alimony victim the law was passed to help.
- Florida's multibillion dollar divorce industry is completely unregulated by any outside agency despite the fact it is created by the state. Florida's Attorney General has never investigated fraud in this industry despite the fact that it's many victims can prove it and even when many of the victims are elderly.
- Florida's divorce and alimony laws are so liberally construed and applied that people come to Florida from other states and even other countries just to get a divorce and receive permanent lifetime alimony and their ex-spouse doesn't even have to be present.
- A Florida marriage license grants a Florida family court judge the right to control your assets, your children, and your entire life through alimony statutes until the day you die should you get divorced and that it is illegal for a minister to perform a marriage without the couple having a state marriage license.
- A Florida family court judge can make you pay alimony based on income you don't even have or produce just by saying that you "could" earn it.
- A Florida family court judge can make you work and provide income for a perfectly healthy adult for the rest of your life with threat of imprisonment if you don't, even though the 13th amendment of the U.S. Constitution says it cannot be done and the U.S. Supreme court has defined this as involuntary servitude. Yet the Florida legislature gives judges permission to do this.
